The $5^{\text {th }}$ Outing of the year takes us to Dorney Court \& Gardens near Windsor where you can enjoy the beautiful gardens and acres of mature parkland surround the house completing a picture of tranquil rural harmony.
Ancient yew hedges and herbaceous borders divide lush green lawns are framed by ornamental trees. In the woods there is an ongoing programme of felling, coppicing and re-planting that aims to restore native species and reveal the sparkling waters of the Saxon Pike Pond. Shrouded in ivy and overhung by great chestnut trees a Norman ice house overlooks the pond and its resident population of kingfishers, carp and watchful herons.
To the south of Dorney Court lies an English rose garden where Queen Elizabeth and Winchester Cathedral compete for space in beds which echo the contours of the House. The centrepiece of the rose garden is a contemporary fountain that takes the form of an Indian elephant enjoying a cooling shower.
A Cream tea will be held in the Crocus Garden Centre, which is part of the Dorney Estate.
